Bearcats drop conference opener to Stony Brook

In the team's conference opener, Binghamton fell behind 6-0 at the half and lost 9-4 to the reigning America East champions. The Seawolves defeated Binghamton 23-3 last season. The game is the only one of the Bearcats five conference games that will be played on the road. The Seawolves scored twice in the first 10 minutes of the game and exploded for four goals in the second quarter. The Bearcats were outshot 31-25.

Cavallo continues streak

Freshman attacker **Phil Cavallo (Cedarhurst, N.Y./Lawrence)** continued his streak of scoring at least one goal in every game this season. He netted his lone goal against Stony Brook 4:23 into the fourth quarter, at the time cutting the BU deficit to 7-3. Cavallo has a team-high eight goals in four games and is the first Bearcat to score goals in four consecutive games.

Five different individuals score against Seawolves

In addition to receiving one goal from Cavallo against Stony Brook, the Bearcats also got goals from attackers **Scott Mitchell (Smithtown, N.Y./Hauppauge)** and **Joe Conner (Ijamsville, Md./Urbana)**, as well as defender **Tyler Moore (Guilderland, N.Y.)**. Mitchell netted his third goal of the season, while Conner and Moore each scored their first. Attacker **Brian Morgan (Littleton, Col./Heritage)** recorded his first two assists of the season to round out the scoring for the Bearcats.

Freshman goal streak ends at 22

The goal by Tyler Moore with 2:25 left in the fourth quarter against Stony Brook ended a streak in which the Bearcats' first 22 goals of the season were scored by freshman. To date, 22 of the team's 23 goals have been scored by first-year players.

Home opener set for Saturday at 1 p.m.

The lone game on the schedule this week is Saturday at 1 p.m. against America East foe Quinnipiac. It will be the first home game of the season for Binghamton and the first of four conference home games.
