### Binghamton faces Iona and Stony Brook this week

The Binghamton women's lacrosse team (1-4, 0-0 AE) has a full slate of games this week starting with a 4:30 p.m. contest on Wednesday against Iona at Binghamton Alumni Stadium. On Friday, the Bearcats head up to Stony Brook for their first conference game of the season against the Seawolves at 7 p.m.

"This is a pretty big week for us," head coach Emily Edmonston said. "We want to get some momentum heading into the conference part of our schedule. To do that, we need to work on playing a consistent game for 60 minutes."

### Weather forces pair of cancellations

A steady dose of snow led to two Binghamton games getting cancelled last week. The Bearcats' March 21 game at St. Francis and their March 26 at home against Quinnipiac were both wiped out due to the weather. It marks the first time in Binghamton's four seasons at the Division I level that two games have been called off in the same year due to weather conditions.

### Edwards making an impact

Sophomore attack **Danielle Edwards (Horseheads, N.Y.)** has made the most of her first season on the squad. Through five games she has a team-high 10 goals, four assists and 14 points.

Edwards is averaging 2.00 goals per game and 2.80 points per game. Her best game of the season has been a four-goal, one assist performance in Binghamton's 14-11 win over Siena on March 17.

In her freshman season, Edwards played for Utica College.

"Danielle has become a scoring threat for us," Edmonston said. "She is a very tenacious player who is a threat every time she has the ball."

### Growing up in a hurry

Of the 21 players currently on Binghamton's roster, only seven are upper-classmen. The Bearcats have five seniors and two juniors.

Of the other 14 players, 10 are sophomores and four are freshmen. In addition, four of the team's top five scorers are sophomores.
