Last Week's Recap: Army

Binghamton opened its spring season with a 7-0 defeat at Army this past Sunday afternoon. The Bearcats (2-1) posted a 9-7 decision at third doubles, and sent two singles matches to a third-set super tie-break, but came up short.

"Army is a deeper team than we are, so I am pleased with the way we battled against them, particularly at second, third and fourth singles," head coach Jamie Campbell said. "We also improved at the other three singles positions as the match went on."

Freshman **Justina Hakimi (Manhasset, N.Y./Herricks)** and junior **Janine Sadaka (Great Neck, N.Y.)** teamed for the 9-7 win at third doubles, but Army captured the doubles point with wins at the first two positions.

Hakimi and senior **Amy Weissberg (Syosset, N.Y.)** each made it to a third-set super tie-break against Army at second and third singles respectively. They each lost by identical 10-7 scores. Sophomore **Alexis Brill (Syosset, N.Y.)** lost in straight sets at fourth singles, but made it to a tie-break in the second set before losing 7-1.

Brohm joins Bearcats

Binghamton added freshman **Jenilee Brohm (Norcross, Ga./ St. Pius Catholic)** to its roster during the semester break. She was the 2000 Georgia State High School runner-up and was also the regional runner-up in both 1999 and 2002. She was a three-year letterwinner at St. Pius and was the team MVP twice.

"Jenilee will have an immediate impact," Campbell said. "She will bring great energy and athleticism to the team. We think she will help take us to the next level."

This Week: Cornell

Binghamton returns home this week as it hosts Colgate at the Binghamton Tennis Center on Saturday at 7 p.m. It will mark the first of six home matches for the Bearcats this semester.

"It's going to be a close match," Campbell said. "We match up very well against them. After the match against Army, we know what we need to do to improve. It will be good to have the full week of practice."
