Bearcats head to New Hampshire Invitational

After a successful opening weekend at the Colgate Harry Lang Invitational, the Binghamton men's and women's cross country teams head up to the University of New Hampshire this weekend for a six-team invitational. The meet, which begins Saturday at 10 a.m., will be run on the same course as the America East Conference Championships on Oct. 30.

"We focused a lot on pack running at Colgate because this coming weekend will be a tough meet," head coach Annette Acuff said. "We did very well running as a group in our first meet and we need to continue that at New Hampshire."

Four of a kind

Senior **Lindsey Bohrer-Yardley (Oneida, N.Y./ Vernon-Verona-Sherrill)**, and juniors **Erica Angel (Poughkeepsie, N.Y./ Spackenkill)**, **Kathryn Murnane (Rockville Center, N.Y./ Oceanside)** and **Stacey Kramer (Loudonville, N.Y./ Colonie Central)** tied for first in the women's at the Colgate Harry Lang Invitational on Saturday. Binghamton finished first out of five teams in the women's race with 10 points (only the top four runners scored). It marked the third straight year that the women have won the Colgate Harry Lang Invitational team title.

Four in a row

Saturday's race at the Colgate Harry Lang invitational marked the fourth straight year that a Binghamton runner has won the women's individual title. Senior **Lindsey Bohrer-Yardley (Oneida, N.Y./ Vernon-Verona-Sherrill)** won the meet by 27 seconds last season and by 17 seconds in 2002. Lauren Tuchband won the race in 2001.

Shteyn starts off strong

Senior **Sergey Shteyn (Staten Island, N.Y./Tottenville)** was the top men's finisher at the Colgate Harry Lang Invitational on Saturday, clocking a time of 27:42 for the 7,800 meter course. He helped lead the men's team to a second-place finish out of seven competing teams.

Shteyn was also the Bearcats' top runner in their two-mile time trial on Aug. 28. The meet on Saturday, however, marked the first time in his career that he has been Binghamton's top runner in a race. Shteyn has been the Bearcats' second runner in a meet four times in his career.
