Keep in mind:

PSYC 243 is a <u>pre-req/co-req</u> for you experimentals (ex. PSYC 351-Perception), which means you need to complete 243 with a C or higher, or take it at the same time.

Experimental Labs (ex. PSYC 352- Lab in Perception) and psychology seminars have PSYC 243 & PSYC 344 as <u>pre-regs.</u> You <u>cannot</u> take them as co-regs.

Though Psyc seminars are open to Juniors and Seniors, it is advised you take them during your senior year. The smaller class sizes allow professors to get to know you, which means they can write letters of recommendation.
