## Minor in General Anthropology

### *Minor Requirements (24 credits)*

A	THREE (3) 100/200-level courses in Anthropology (12 cr.)			
B	TWO (2) 300/400-level courses in Anthropology (8 cr.). ANTH 491 is not allowed.			
C	ONE (1) elective course (4 cr.) taken at the upper-level (300/400 level) in any subfield of Anthropology or in a related social science, <sup>1</sup> to be chosen in consultation with the Director of Undergraduate Studies. ANTH 49 is not allowed.			

- A maximum of two courses from any one subfield (sociocultural, linguistic, biological, archaeology) may be counted towards this minor.
- Only courses passed with a grade of C- or better may count towards minor requirements
- No courses taken under the Pass/Fail option may count towards minor requirements
- A total of 24 credits are required for completion of this minor, of which at least 12 credits must be taken in Anthropology at Binghamton University.
