Minor in General Anthropology

Minor Requirements

A	ONE Anthropology area course (4 cr.) focused on the peoples/cultures of a specific world region or area (e.g., the Pacific, Middle East, Southeast Asia, North Africa, etc). Choose among ANTH 251-273, 340-344, 367-370, 374-379 ¹	
B	ONE 200-level course in Anthropology (4 cr.)	
C	TWO courses in Anthropology (8 cr.) taken at the 100/200 level	
D	ONE elective course (4 cr.) taken at the upper-level (300/400 level) in any subfield of Anthropology or in a related social science, ² to be chosen in consultation with the Director of Undergraduate Studies. ANTH 491 is not allowed.	
E	TWO 300/400 level courses in Anthropology (8 cr.). A maximum of 4 credits total of any combination of ANTH 393/493/495/497/499 is allowed; ANTH 491 is not allowed.	

- A maximum of two courses from any one subfield (sociocultural, linguistic, biological, archaeology) may be counted towards this minor.
- Only courses passed with a grade of C- or better may count towards minor requirements
- No courses taken under the Pass/Fail option may count towards minor requirements
- A total of 24 credits are required for completion of this minor, of which at least 12 credits must be taken in Anthropology at Binghamton University.

Future Planning:

¹/ Most semesters some topics courses (ANTH 280x/380x/480x) will be offered that are designated as “area courses”. The area course used to fulfill Category A may also be used to fulfill one other requirement (B, C, or E).

²/ “Other social sciences” include Economics, Geography, History, Political Science, and Sociology; social science courses in Africana Studies, Asian & Asian-American Studies, Latin American & Caribbean Area Studies, and Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies (WGSS) may also be used.
