artistic life of our community.

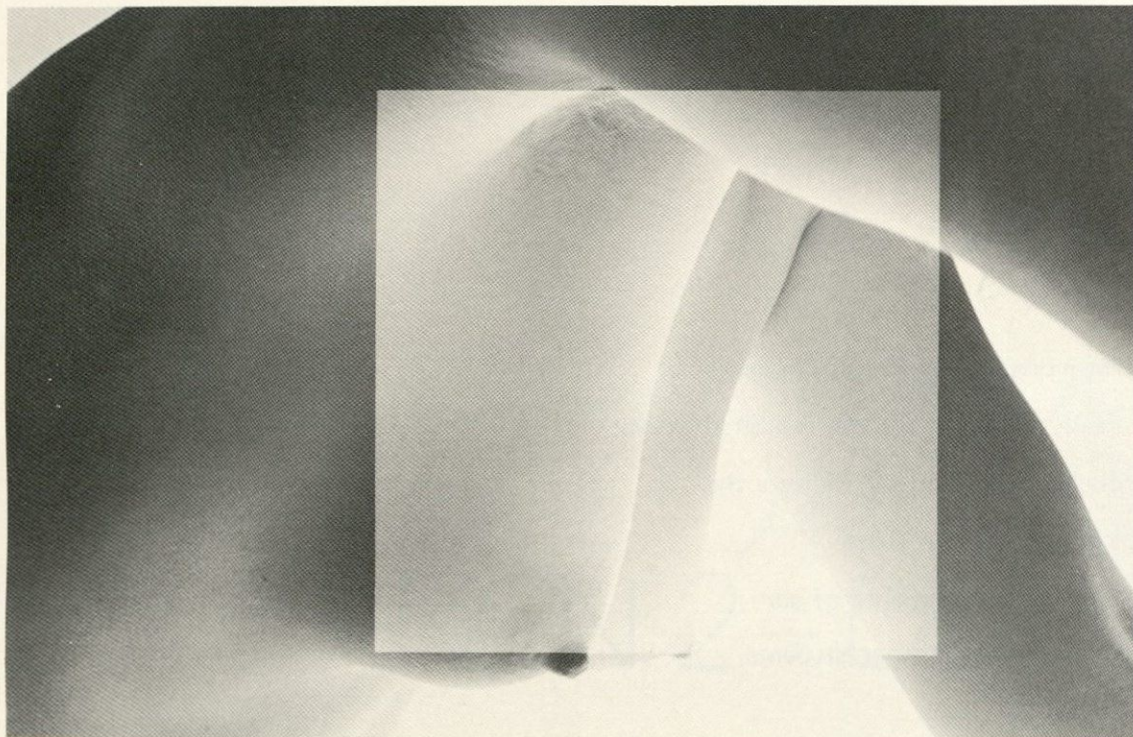
The everlasting search for individual expression in new

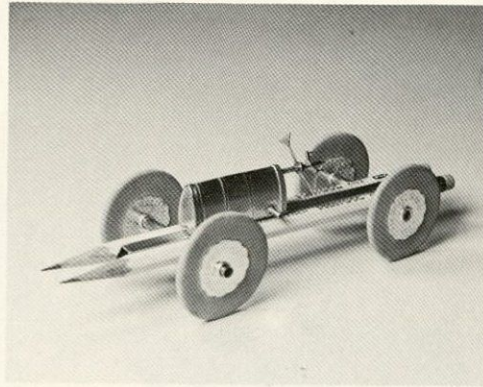

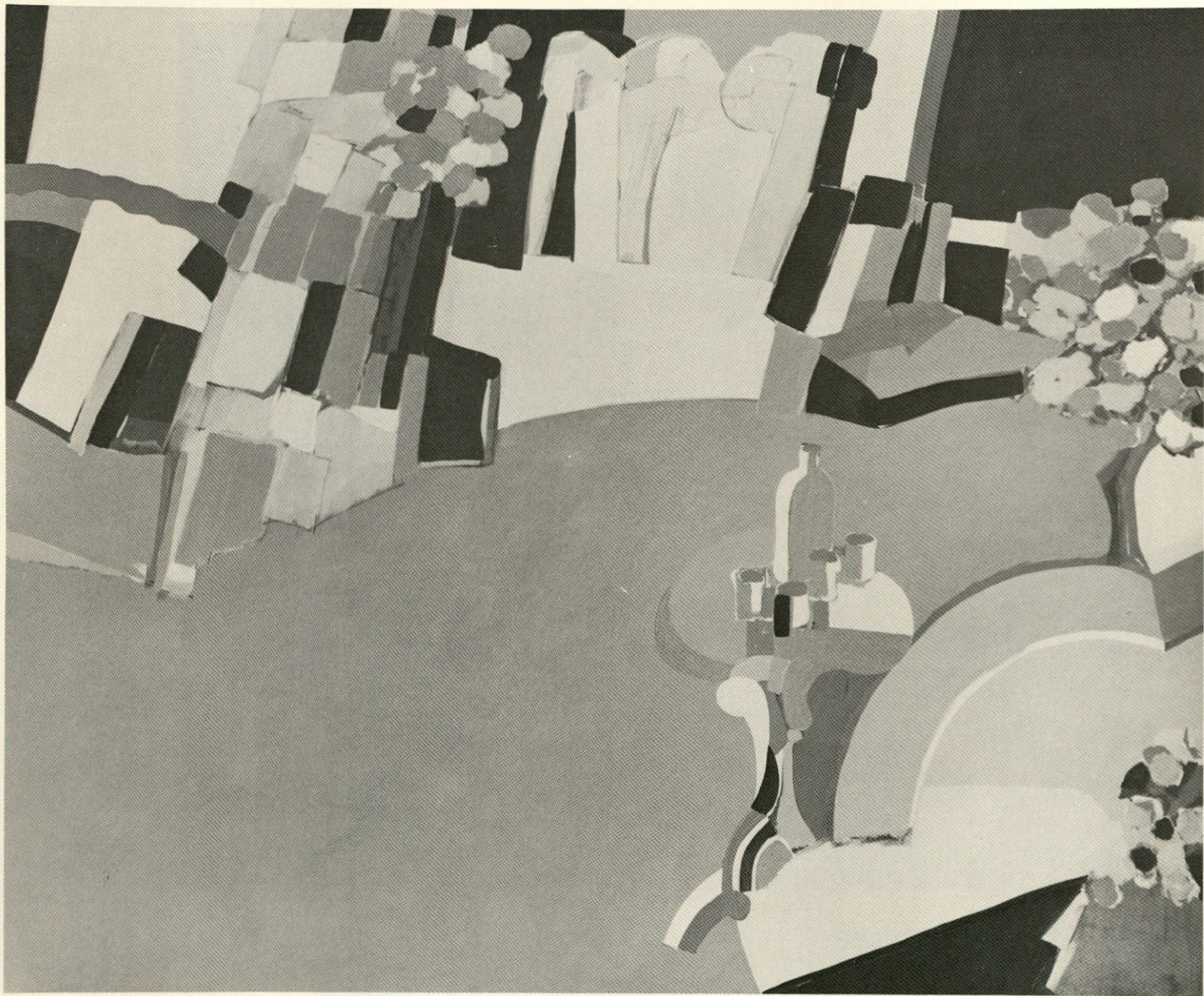

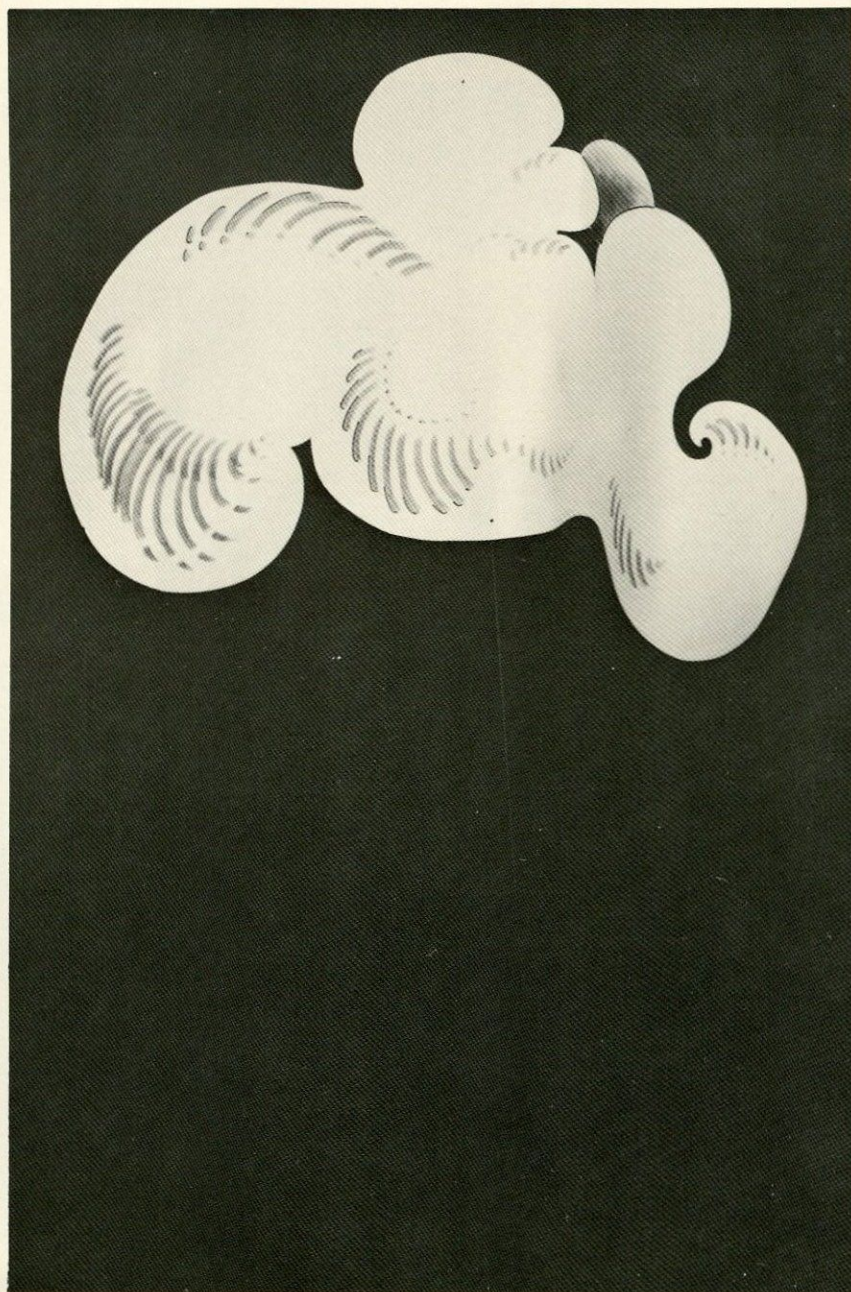

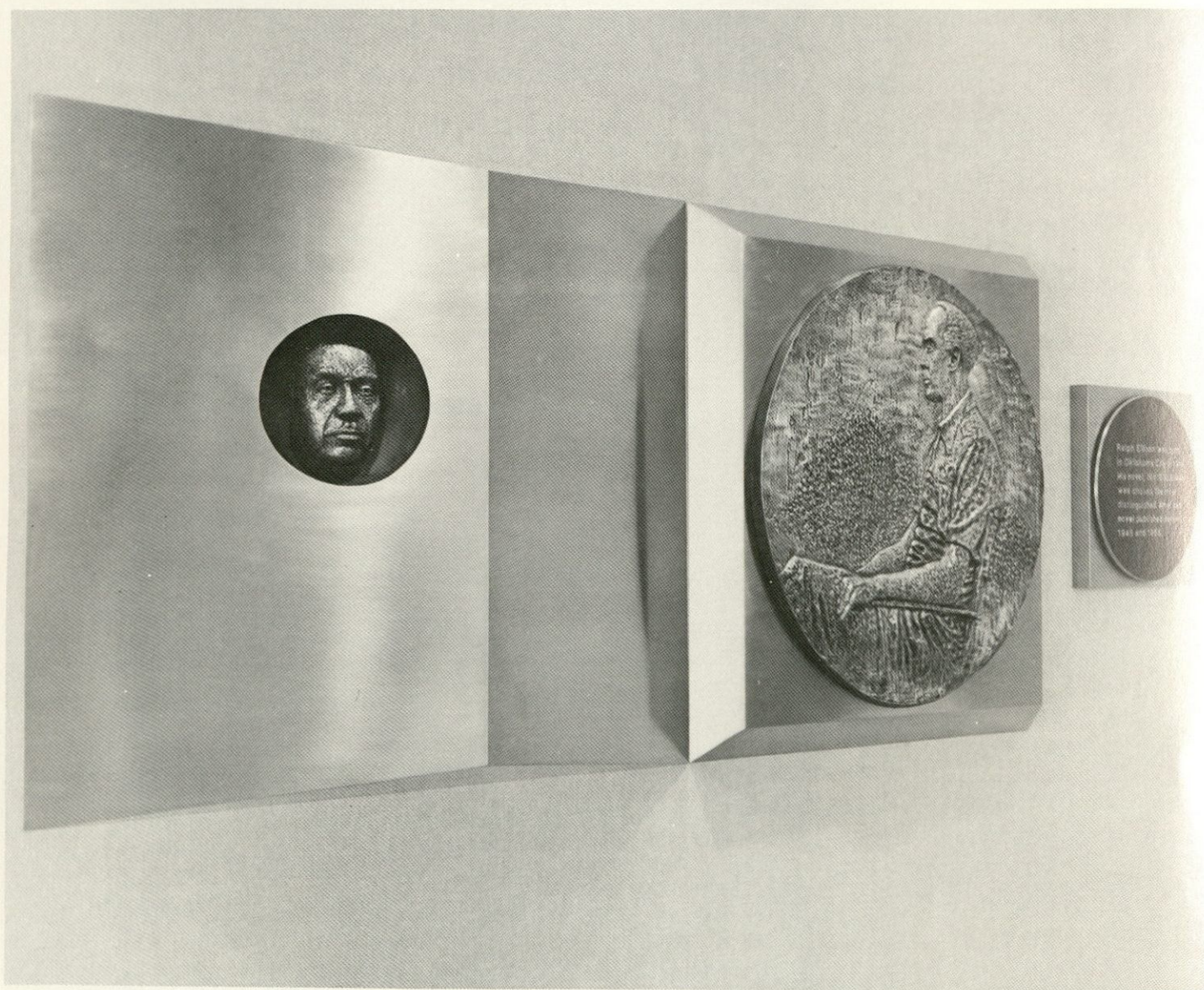
