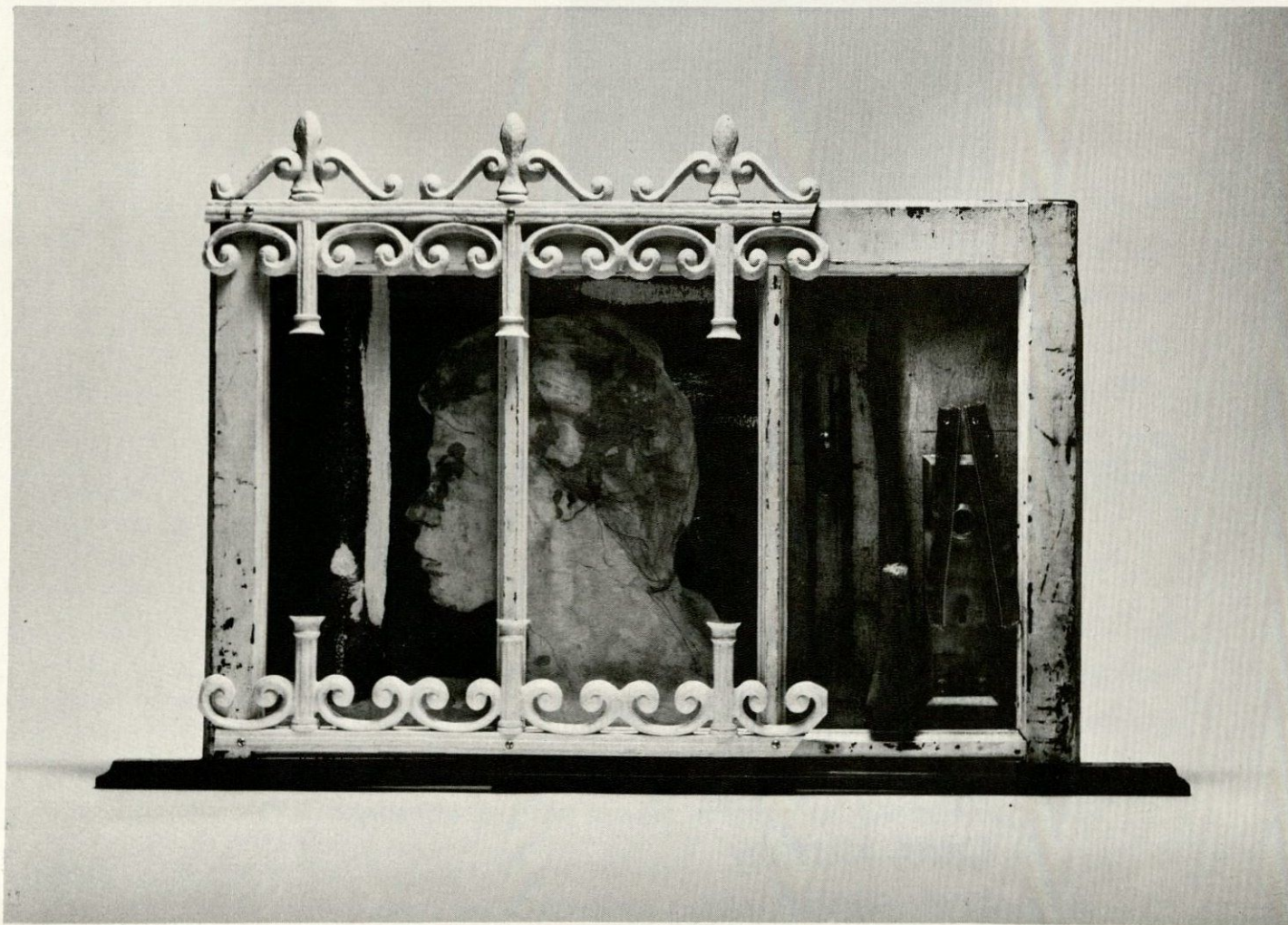

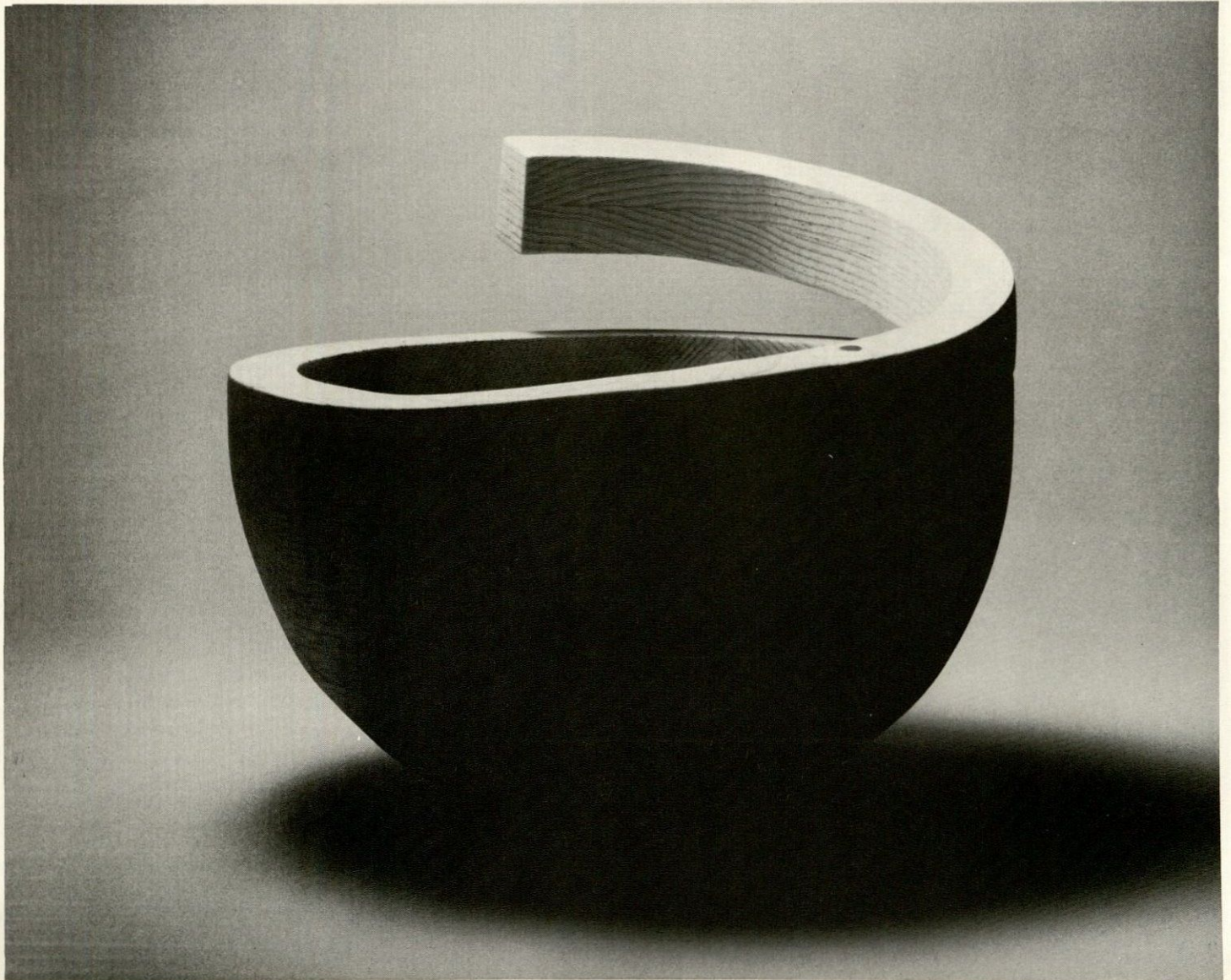


Rocky-H.R. Lee, *Six Years Later*, wood, paper, and metal assemblage, 18" x 25" x 2".

Marguerite Lutton, *Woolworths*, oil on paper, 20" x 26".



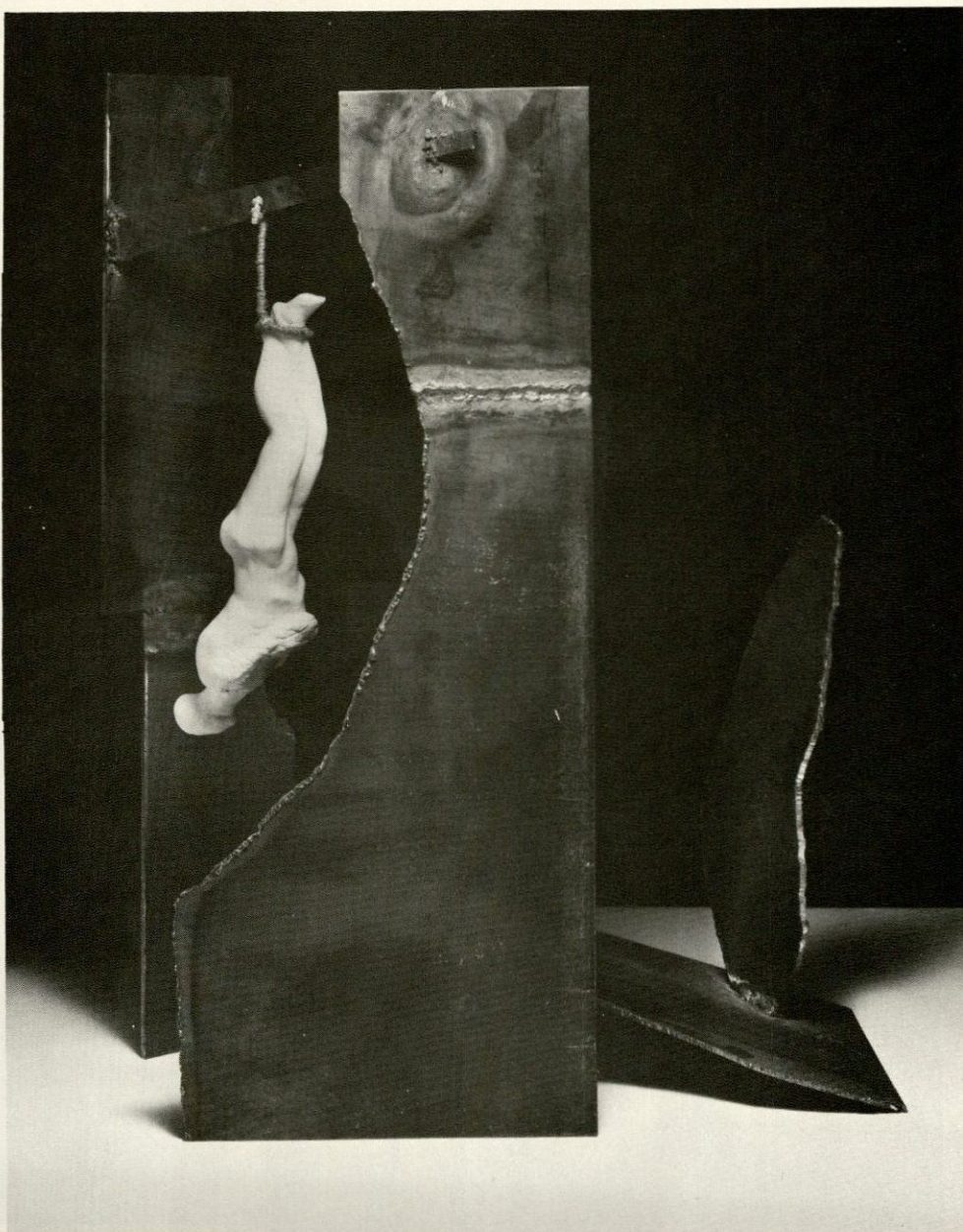

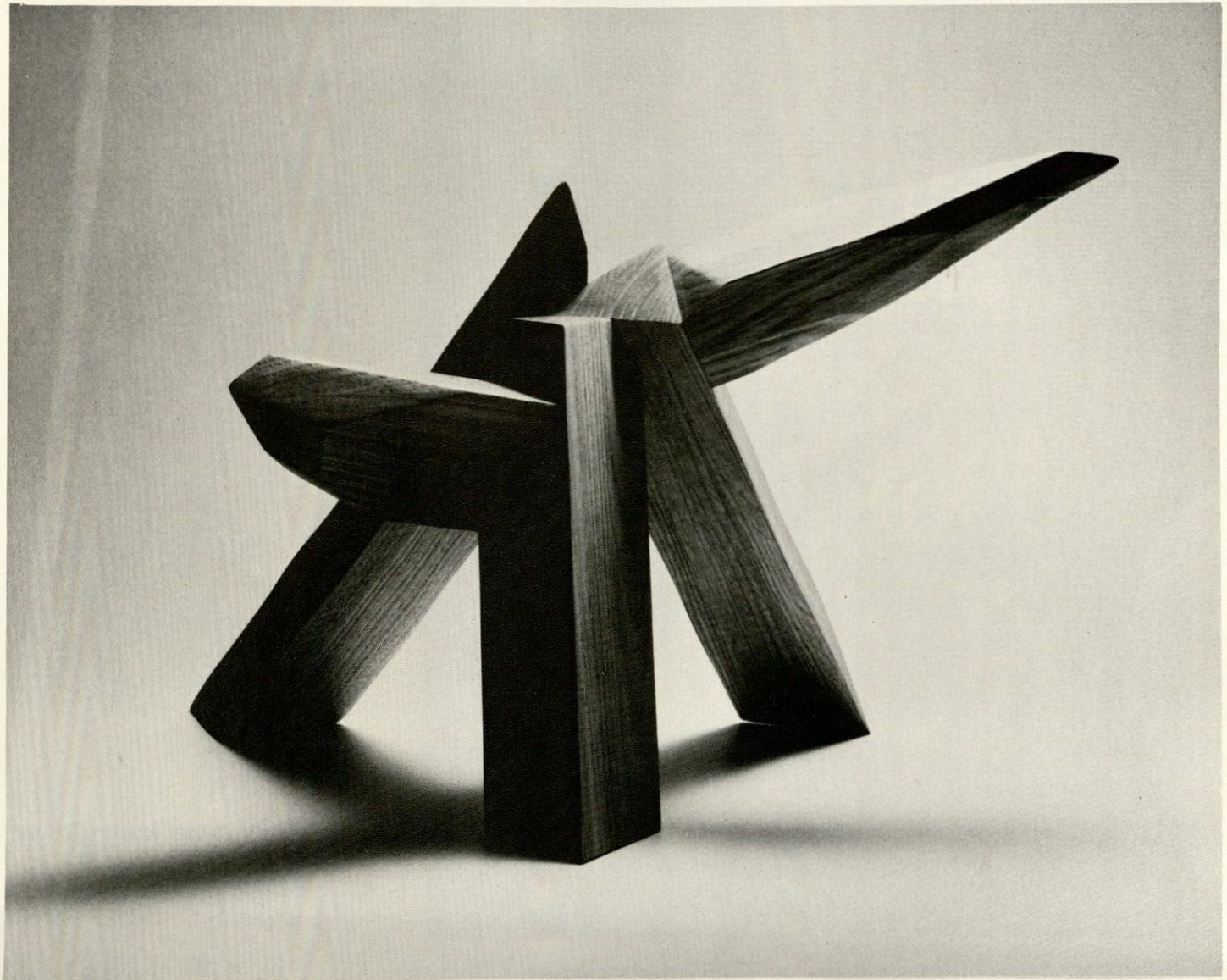

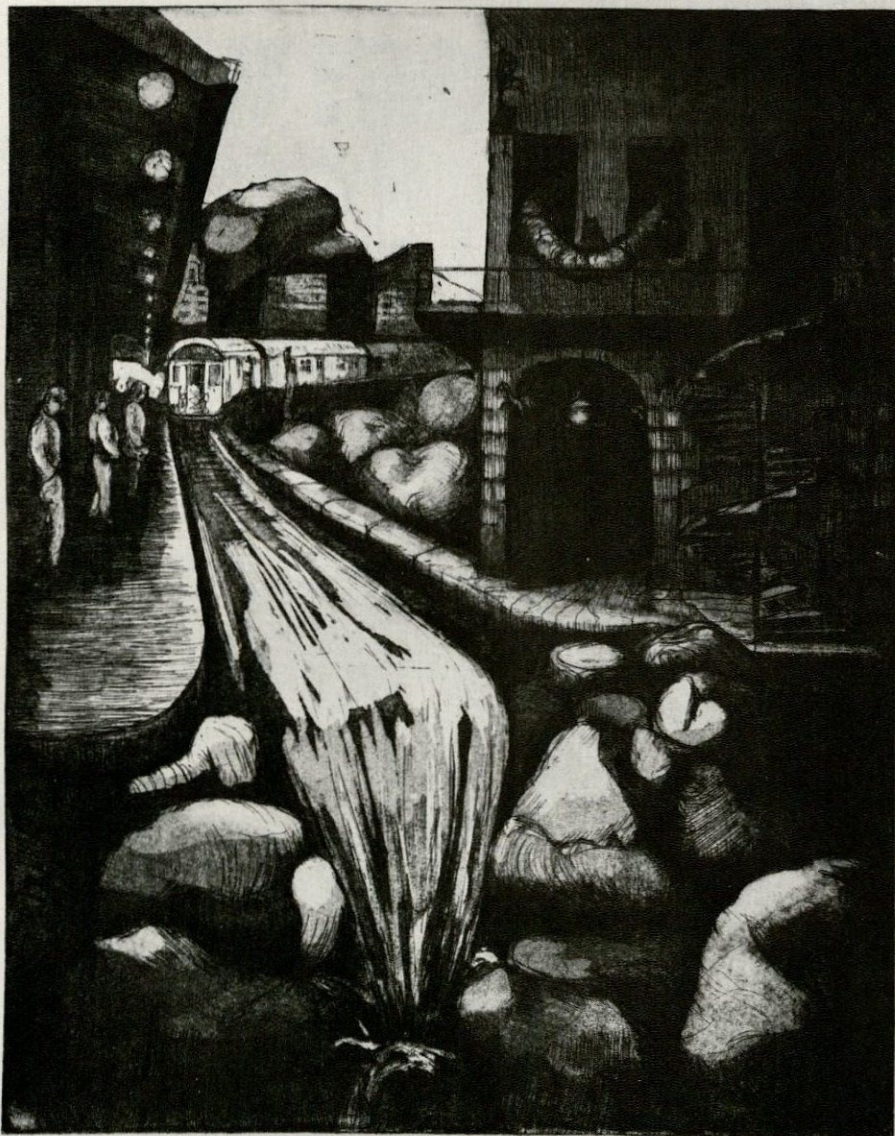

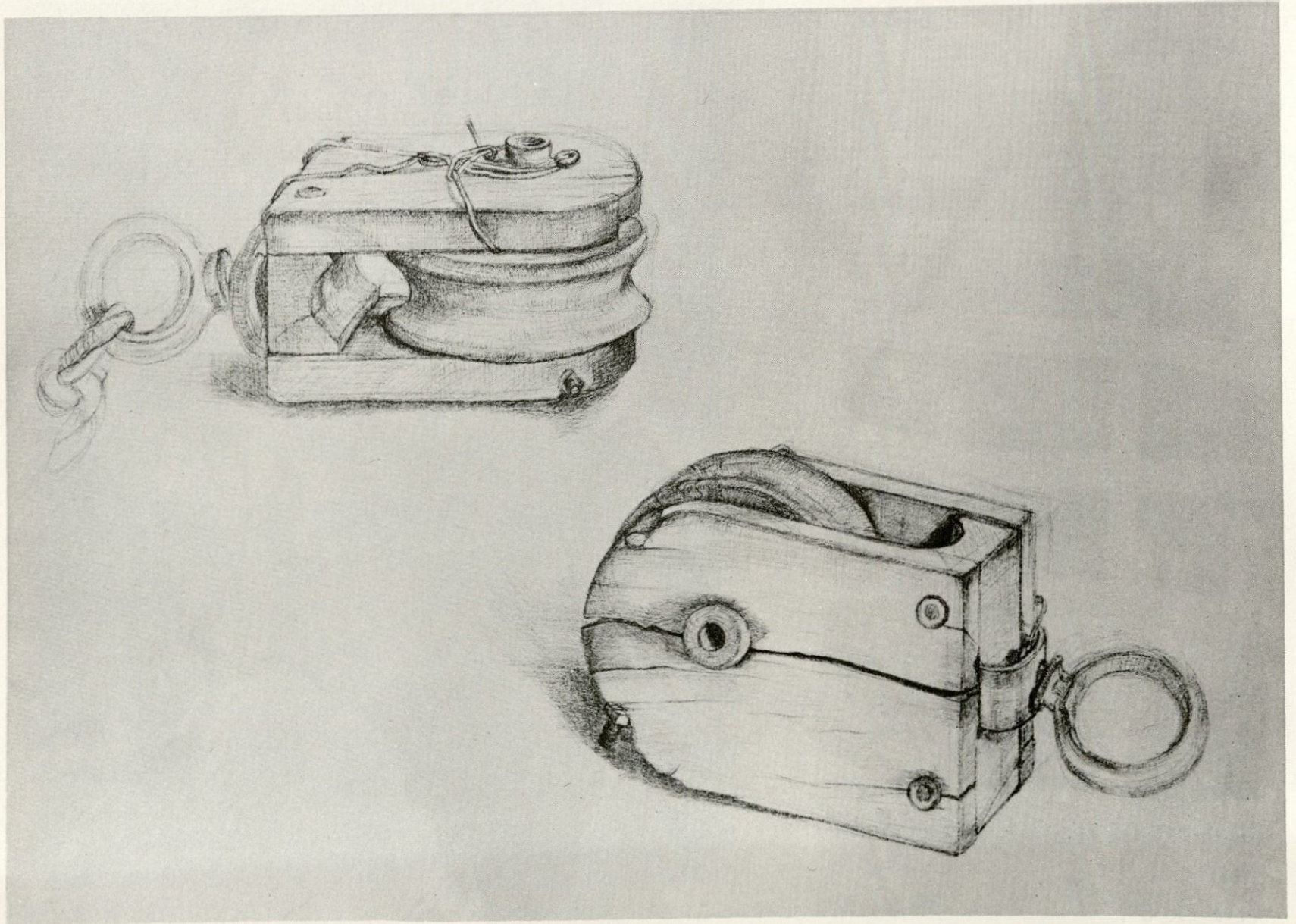


*Mangrove I & II* 1/10 K. Clegg - A/H

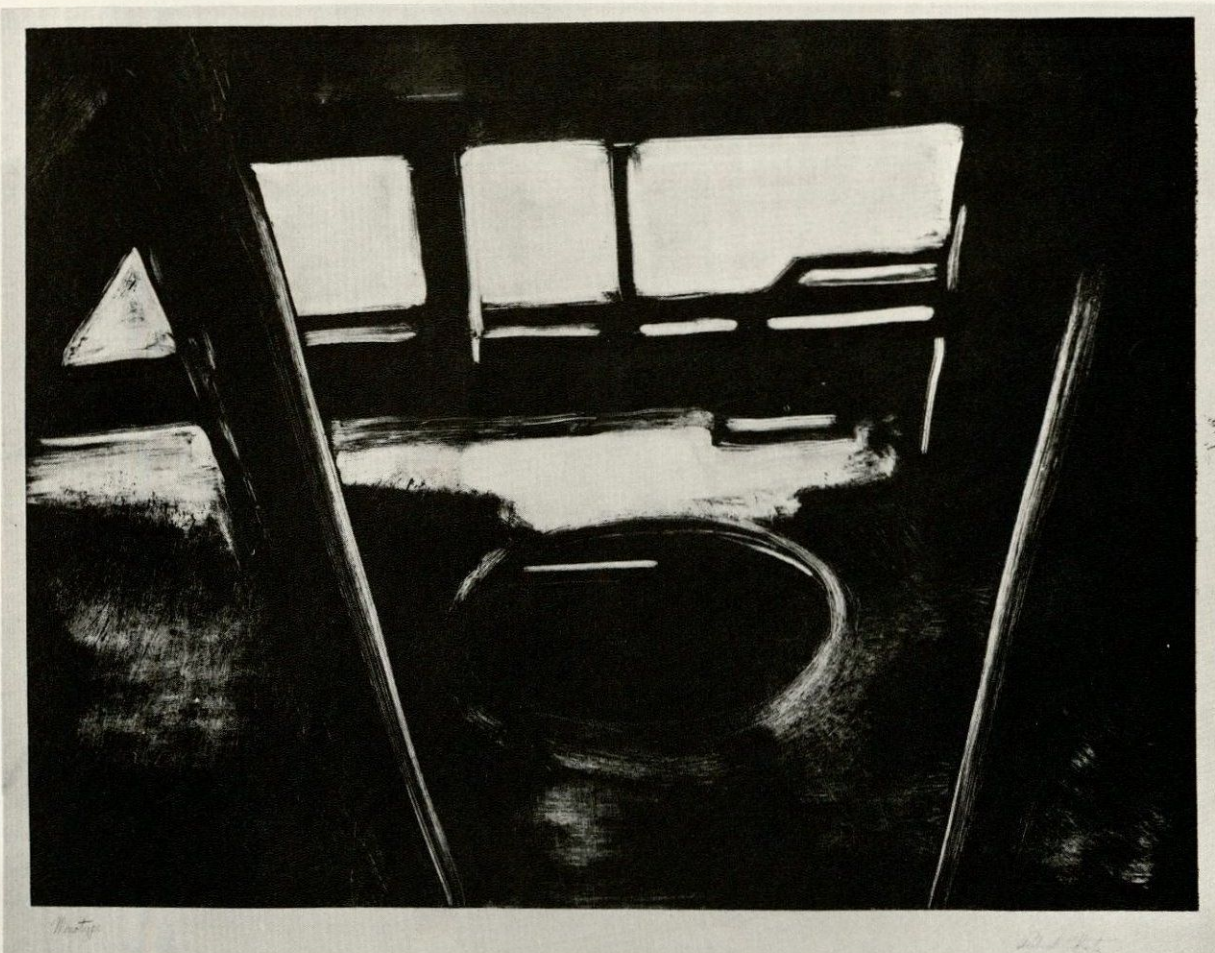

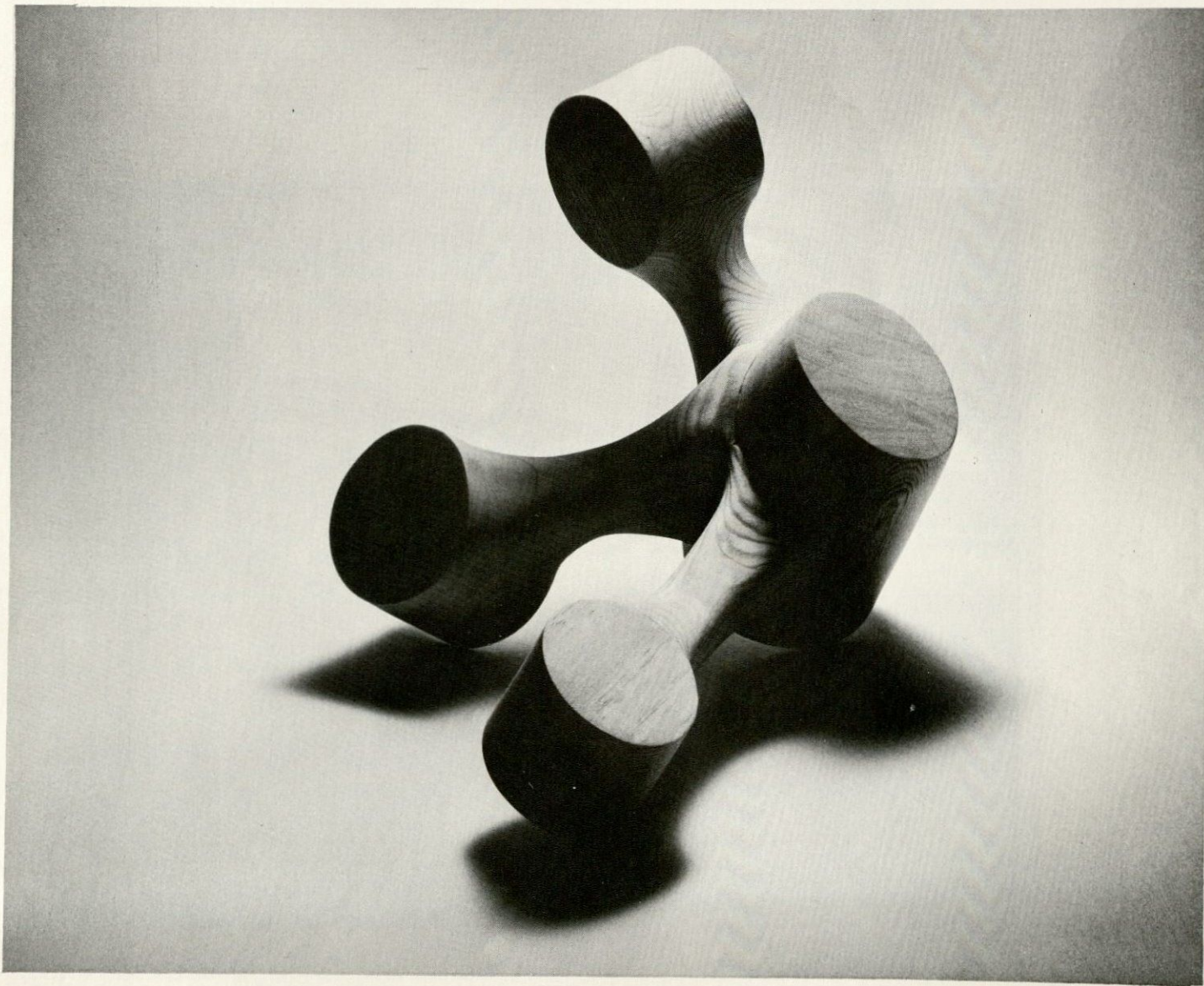

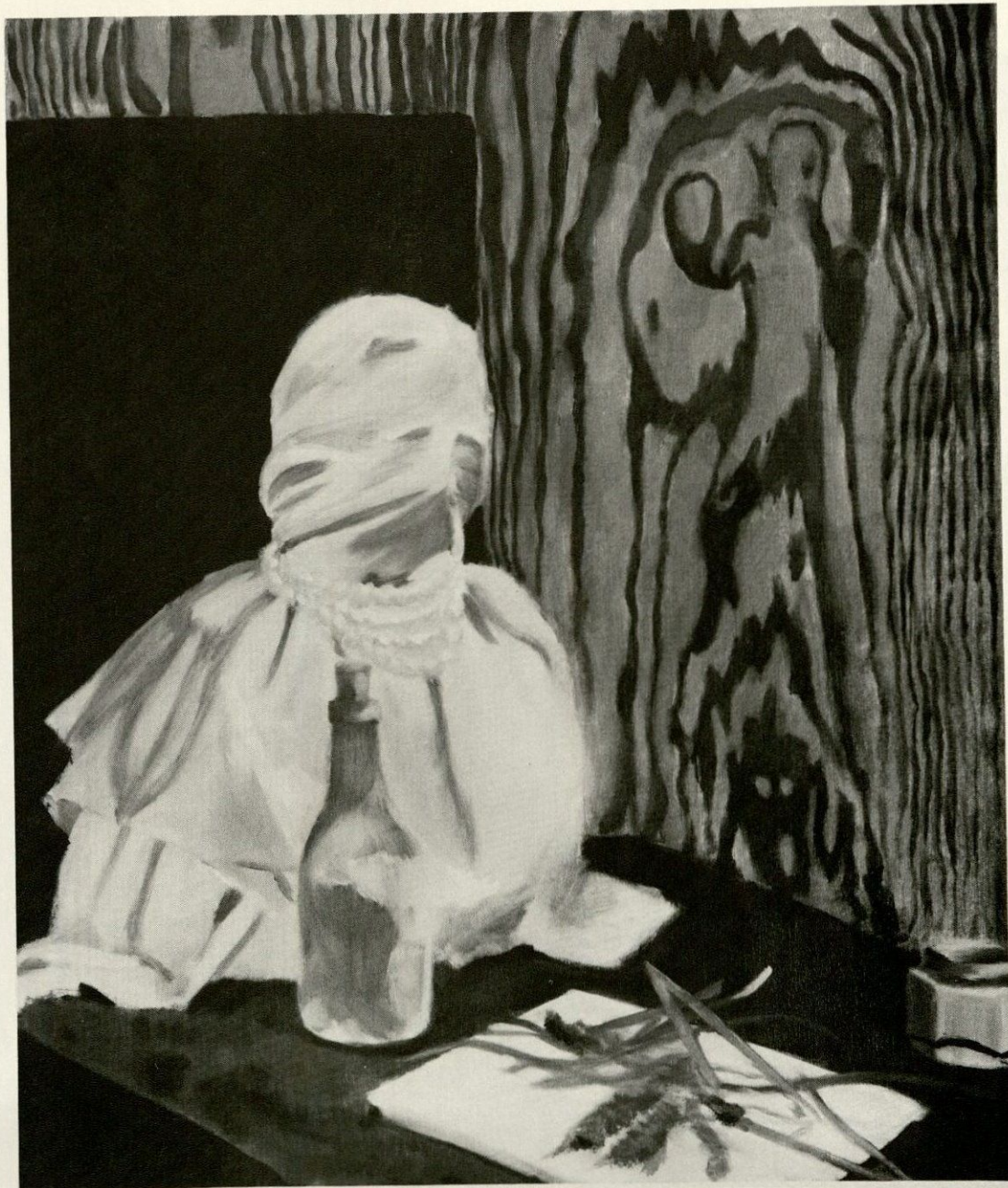


Joseph Bell, *Untitled*, wood, 15½ x 13½" x 11".

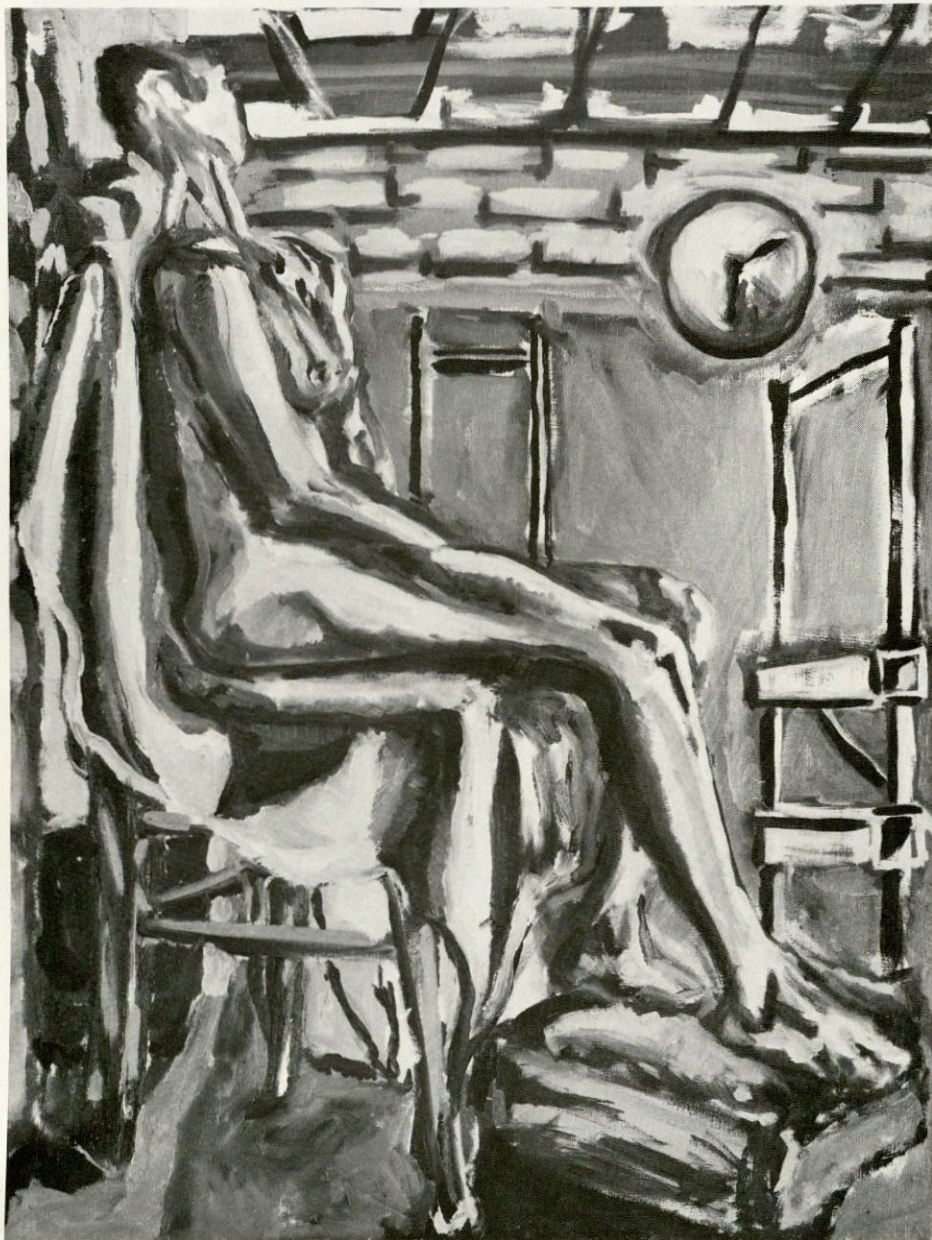

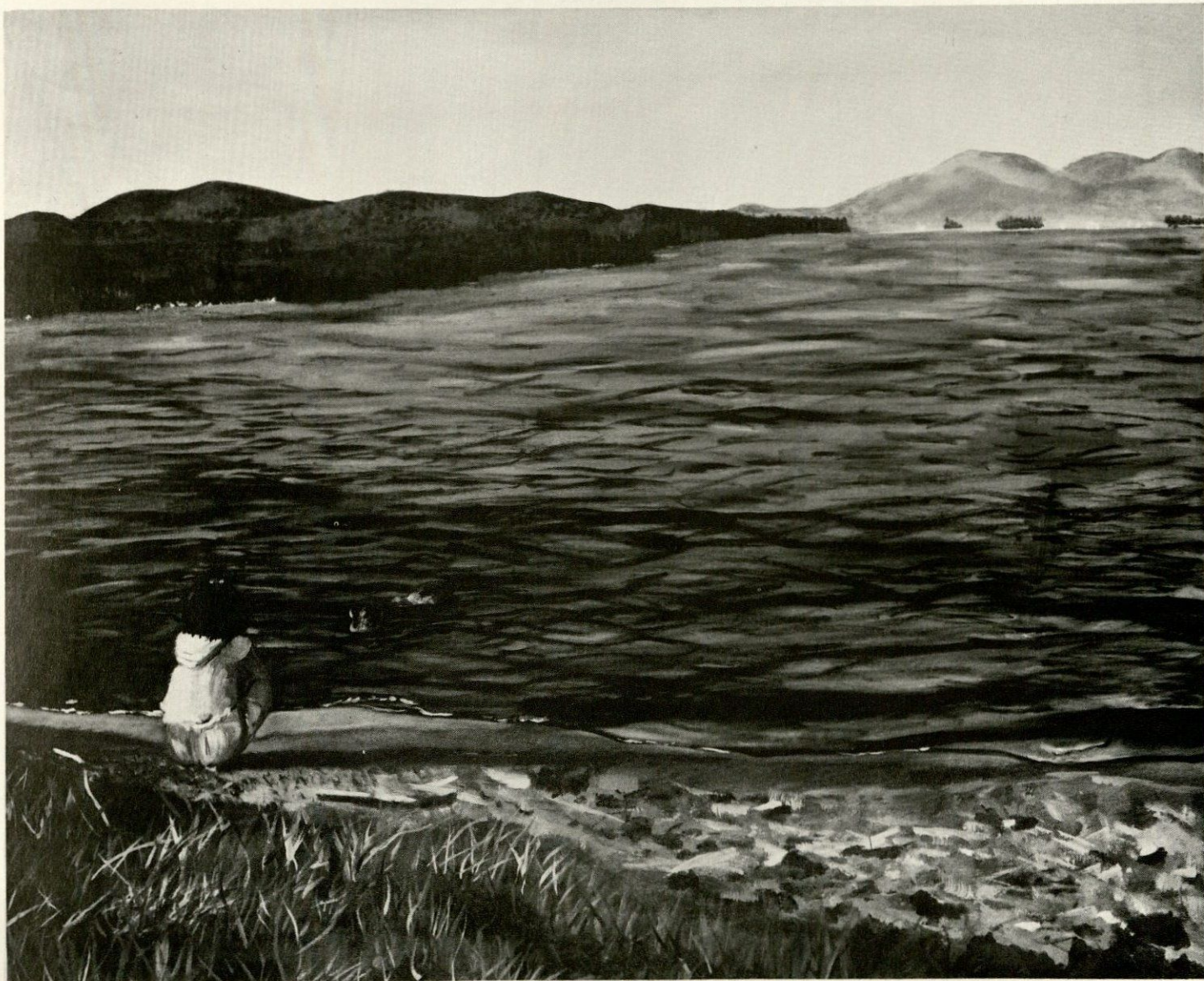




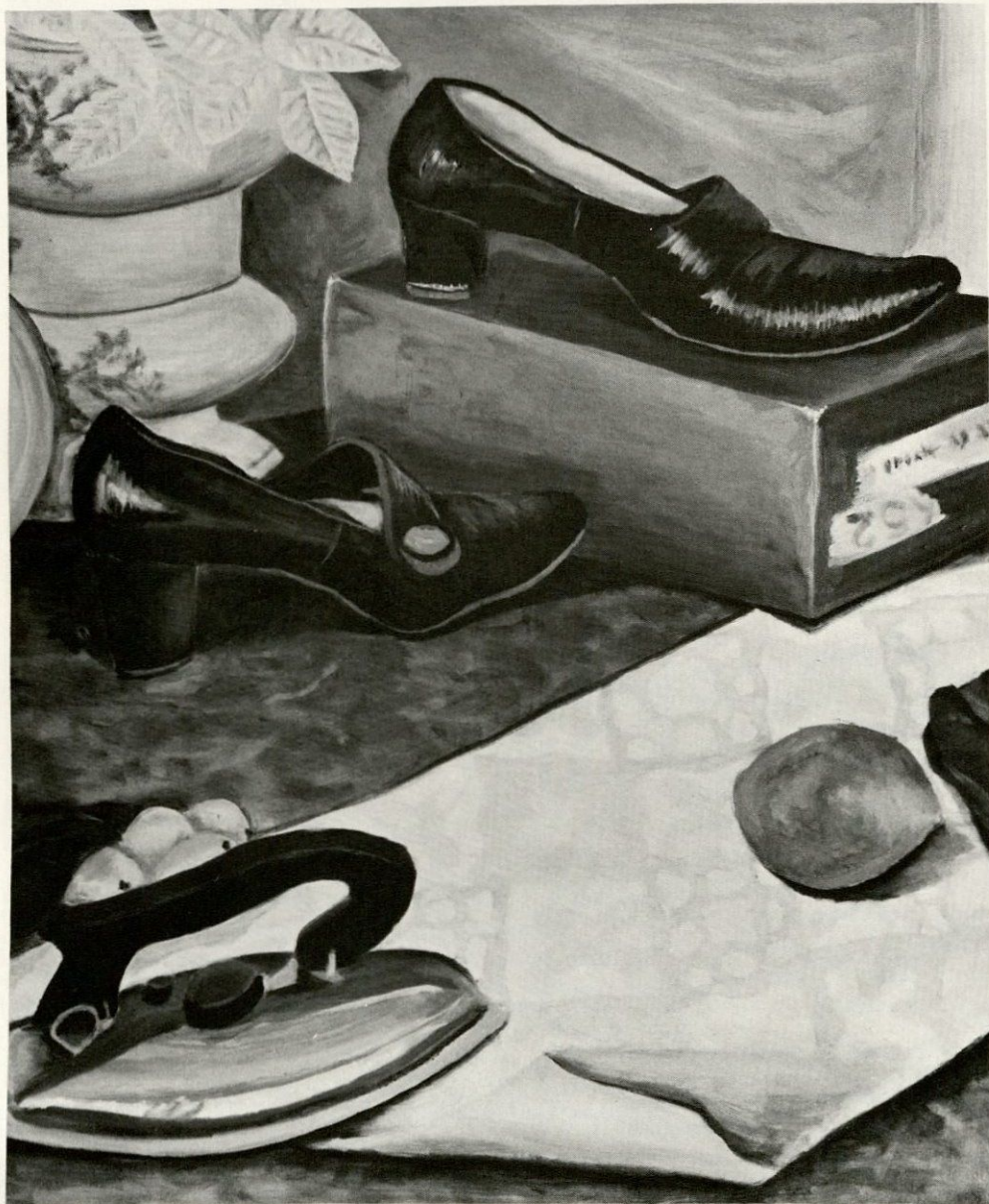

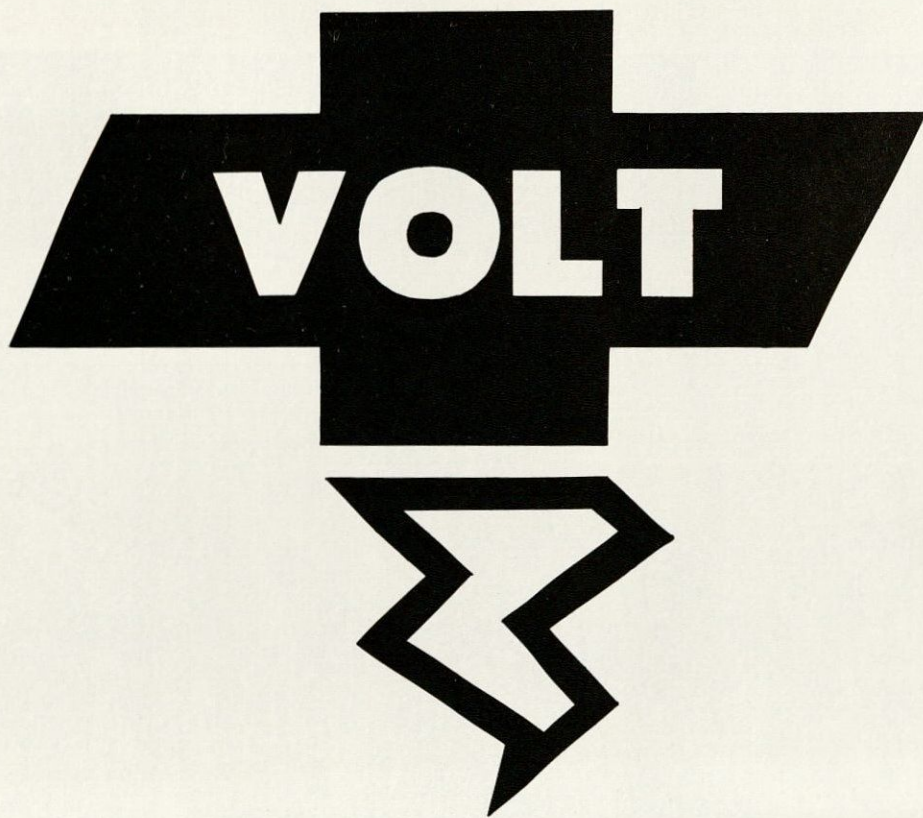


Scott Henson, *When there is clutter here I flutter*, oil on canvas, 14" x 24".
