

COURSES AND PREREQUISITES – WINTER 2023

Grade Requirements: Prerequisites must have been completed with a grade of C or better BEFORE taking the course. The grade requirements for the BA are different for calculus and statistics than for the BS. B- or better is required for the BS majors.

Courses completed with a C-, D or P do not satisfy prerequisite requirements (P grades received Spring 2020 are the exception). Students with prerequisite courses in progress during advance registration may register, but will be dropped if they do not receive a grade of C or better. Courses may not be taken concurrently with the course for which they are a prerequisite (e.g., calculus is a prerequisite for ECON 360 and may not be taken at the same time as ECON 360).

Statistics Requirements include: AP 3 or equivalent college level statistics course (ECON 366; CQS 112; MATH 147, 148, 448; PSYC 243).

Calculus Requirements include: AP 3 or equivalent college level calculus course (MATH 220, 221, or both MATH 224 and 225).
