REMEMBER:

- 1) Courses completed with a C-, D or P do not satisfy prerequisite requirements. Students with prerequisite courses in progress during **advance registration** may register, but will be dropped if they do not receive a grade of C or better.
- 2) Courses may not be taken concurrently with the course for which they are a prerequisite (e.g., calculus is a prerequisite for ECON 360 and may not be taken at the same time as ECON 360).

* Or AP 3 or equivalent college level statistics course (ECON 366; CQS 112; MATH 147, 148, 448; PSYC 243).

** Or AP 3 or equivalent college level calculus course (MATH 220, 221, or both MATH 224 **and** 225).

*** These courses MAY be opened to **other schools** at the start of the semester. Check with your advising office.
