# **FACULTY BYLAWS**

Proposed changes relative to SUNY Faculty Senate submitted to Faculty Senate 032012

### **Explanation**

Changes address the additional representative to University Faculty Senate. Starting in Fall 2010, Binghamton has two faculty representatives to the University Faculty Senate.

## **ARTICLE III**

#### ORGANIZATION AND PROCEDURES

## **Title B. Faculty Senate**

- 3. **Representation**. Representation shall be by academic unit and by academic sub-unit.
- f. The Faculty Senate shall include the faculty member(s) who is/are the elected representative(s) to the SUNY-wide Faculty Senate, and these representatives shall not be counted against the number of representatives allotted to his/her academic unit or sub-unit.
- 5. **Executive Committee**. There shall be an Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate.
- b. Composition.
- iv. The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the Senate and the Faculty Senator(s) representing the faculty to the SUNY Faculty Senate shall be ex officio voting members of the Executive Committee and, if not already a member of the Executive Committee, the size of the Executive Committee shall be (temporarily) increased. (Approved by faculty in mail ballot in March 2006)

# **ARTICLE V**

# EXTRAMURAL REPRESENTATION OF THE VOTING FACULTY

## Title A. Faculty Senate of SUNY

- 1. **Election**. The voting faculty, in conjunction with the professional employees, shall, by secret ballot, elect its representatives to the Faculty Senate for a three-year term. The faculty representatives shall be elected from a slate of two or more candidates nominated by the Committee on Committees. In like manner, one alternates shall be elected.
- 2. **Duties**. The Senators or his/her alternates shall represent the voting faculty of the State University of New York at Binghamton in the SUNY Senate and shall serve as an ex officio voting member of the Executive Committee and the Faculty Senate. (Approved by faculty in mail ballot in March 2006)
