FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR FALL SEMESTERS, 2008-2013

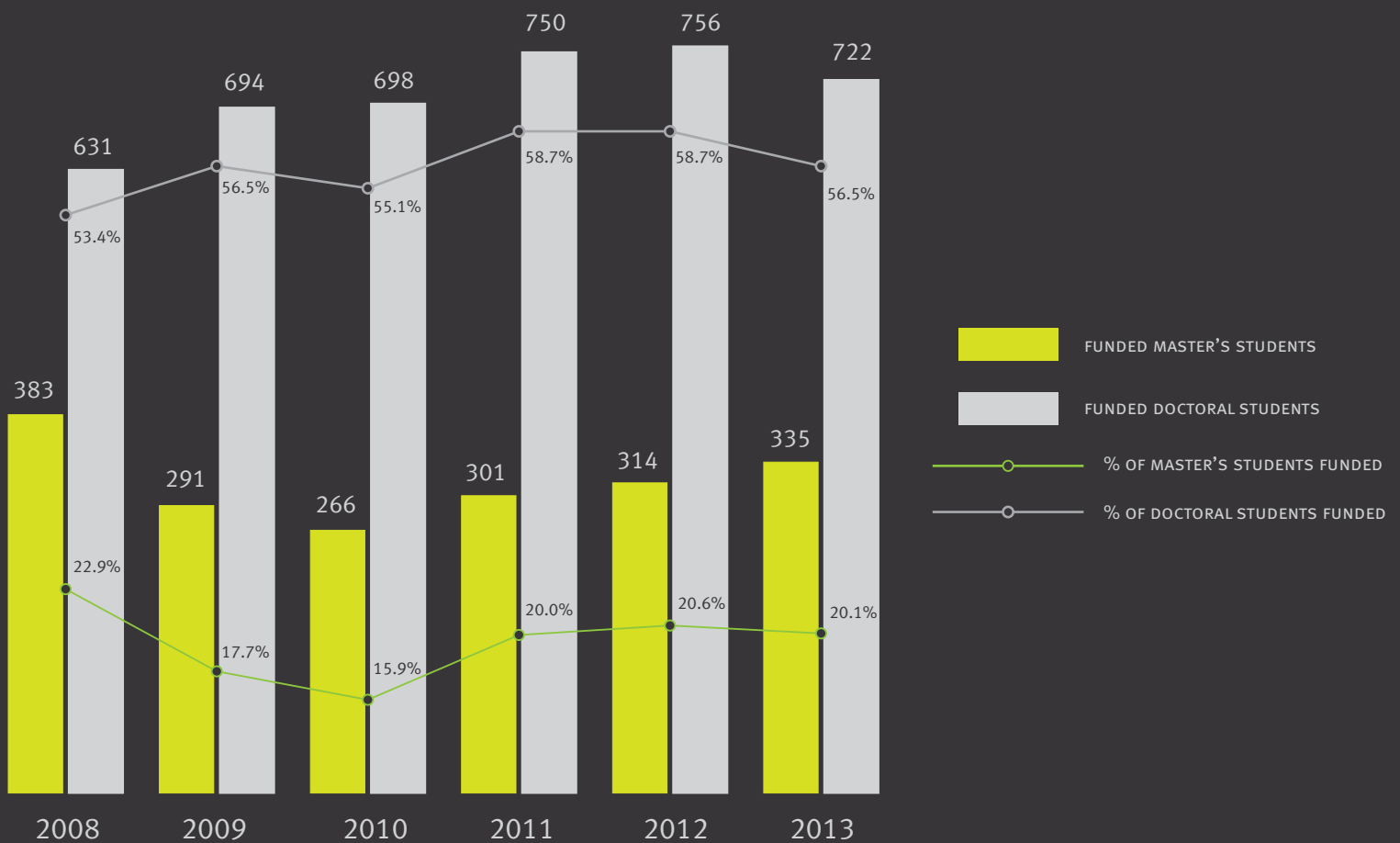

DOCTORAL STUDENTS BY TYPE OF FUNDING, FALL 2013

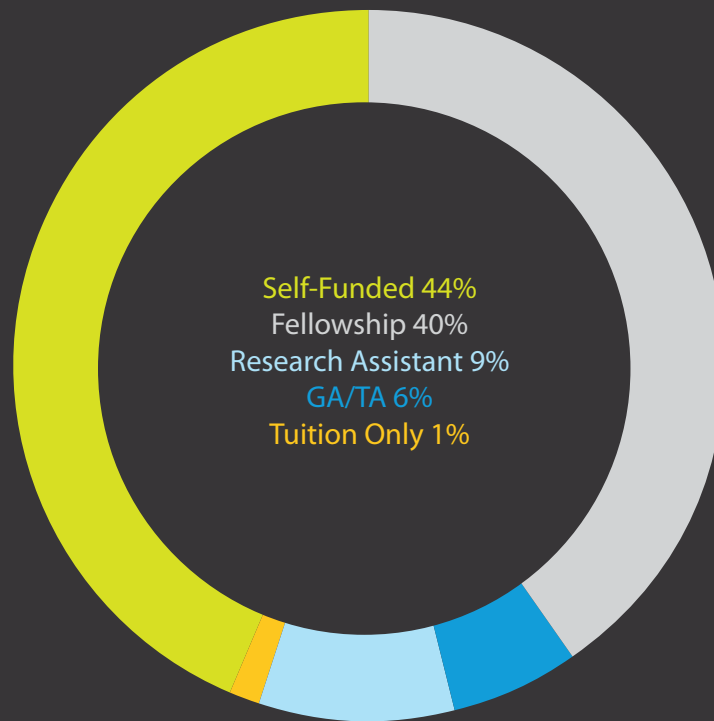
