The Dr. Bhagwan Gajwani Fellowship is awarded each year to two graduates of Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Gujarat, India, who fulfill the admission requirements for Binghamton University and are accepted into a master's program in any of the following fields: Economics, Business Administration, Computer Science, Engineering. If there are not any eligible candidates from MSU, the fellowship may be awarded to students who meet the criteria above and graduated from other universities in India. All applicants must reside in India at the time of application.

The recipients should exhibit excellence in academics, character, leadership, community service, and overall performance, as evidenced by letters of recommendation from their dean and two other members of their faculty. The award provides a stipend of \$12,000 and a full tuition scholarship (dependent on current rates) for the first year of study, but the fellow must pay all University fees.

Recipients are expected to fund themselves after the first year of study. The Dr. Bhagwan Gajwani Fellowship shall be awarded without regard to the gender, race, religion, caste, or financial need of the students.
