



Binghamton Study Abroad Credit

Binghamton faculty-taught courses	Course equivalents, including general education and writing credit approvals, for courses taught by Binghamton faculty members will be listed on the abroad program website. Please refer to the program website for this information. All other requests should follow the procedures below.	
-Major/Minor	Please have relevant coursework reviewed by your academic department using the <i>Course Approval Towards Major or Minor Credit</i> form. This form should be returned to Education Abroad (IEGI) upon completion.	
-General Education -Harpur Writing	<p>Once you have selected courses to petition, please submit them to Harpur Advising for review using the petition located here:</p> <p>Forms & Petitions → Transfer Credit and Study Abroad Petition: Gen Ed, Writing, and Elective Credit</p> <p>(Please be sure to use the form labeled <i>Binghamton University Study Abroad Program Credit Petition</i>)</p>
