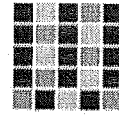

**A Transfer Pathway Articulation Between
Harpur College of Arts and Sciences, Binghamton University,
State University of New York
and
Westchester Community College, State University of New York**

Introduction

This agreement is entered into by and between Harpur College of Arts and Sciences, Binghamton University, State University of New York (hereinafter identified as Binghamton University), and Westchester Community College, State University of New York (hereinafter identified as Westchester Community College).

In an effort to better serve transfer students intending to pursue programs of study in Harpur College of Arts and Science, Binghamton University and Westchester Community College hereby enter into this articulation agreement allowing transfer students to participate in Binghamton University's "2+U" guaranteed transfer admissions program.

Binghamton University recognizes transfer students from Westchester Community College who wish to pursue a baccalaureate degree and will complete an associate degree in:

Binghamton University 2+U program is designed to:

- Facilitate the transition of graduates from a liberal arts associate degree program at Westchester Community College to a baccalaureate degree program in Harpur College of Arts and Sciences at Binghamton University.
- Attract qualified transfer students to both Westchester Community College and Binghamton University.
- Provide information to ensure appropriate advisement for students from faculty and staff at both Westchester Community College and Binghamton University.
- Encourage academic coordination between the faculty and advisors at the two institutions, including curricular reviews.
- Assess and exchange information on the specific outcomes of this articulation program with the goal of continual improvement.
- Allow students to maximize transferability and enter in Junior standing.

Qualifying Students

This agreement pertains to the transfer of “qualifying students”, i.e. those transfer students who:

1. Will successfully complete their associate degree at Westchester Community College.
2. Have matriculated, enrolled, and are in good standing at Westchester Community College;
3. Have a minimum cumulative 3.2 GPA for guaranteed admissions. Candidates whose cumulative GPA is between a 2.8 to a 3.19 will be considered based on space availability and their individual merits by the Binghamton Admissions Committee; and
4. Complete the transfer student application process by February 1st for Fall or November 1st for Spring and submit a transcript inclusive of the most recent semester. Any applicant who applies or submits materials after the deadline will be considered on a space available basis.

All students who participate in the Binghamton University 2+U program are expected to complete all course work at Westchester Community College until meeting the academic requirements to successfully transfer to Binghamton University. Requirements for the bachelor’s degree will be those in effect at the time the student transfers to Binghamton University.


Credits awarded through programs including Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB) and the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) will also be considered for transfer based upon official proof of minimum required scores. Each institution hereby agrees to notify the other in the event of substantive changes in a course, programs or policies at its institution that would impact the agreement, including the courses and provisions herein.

In June 2021, Harpur College of Arts and Science, Binghamton University and Westchester Community College agree to enter into an articulation agreement as described above, via one through three in the Articles of Articulation.


Evaluation of this agreement will occur every five years. At the request of either party, a review of the contents, updates and/or implementation of the agreement will be conducted by the institutions. Binghamton University and/or Westchester Community College will give not less than one calendar year's written notice for a termination of the articulation agreement. Termination of the Agreement will not adversely affect any students currently enrolled at or accepted to Binghamton University at the time of termination.





Articles of Articulation

There are three groups of requirements that all students must complete in order to receive a Bachelor of Arts (BA) or Bachelor of Science (BS) from Harpur College of Arts and Sciences at Binghamton University. These requirements fall under the following categories: Harpur College, General Education (GenEd), and academic major.

3. All students who participate in this agreement and enroll at Binghamton University are expected to adhere to all general administrative and academic policies and procedures. The Binghamton University Bulletin and Student Handbook specify University policies and procedures. Additional Harpur College policies may be found on the Harpur College Academic Advising website or the Harpur College website. Academic departments and programs may have other more detailed information specific to their area. All students are held to the degree requirements in the University Bulletin for their academic year of matriculation.

Harpur College believes that writing is central to a liberal arts education. To ensure that all students obtain considerable experience and receive significant guidance or instruction during their studies, Harpur College has developed specific writing requirements for all majors within Harpur College. The requirements in composition (C), writing (W) and/or joint composition/writing (J) are:

- Two C/J courses and 3 Ws or;
- Three C/J Courses and 1 W;
- Four C/J courses

Students are allowed to transfer up to 1 (C) or (J) course and 2 (W) courses.
