

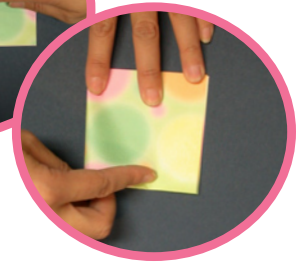
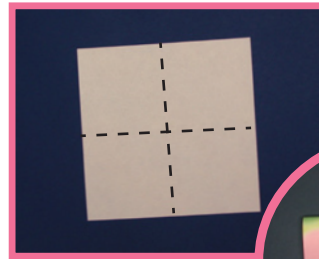
How to Make Your Own Origami Frog



All you need is a square sheet of paper.

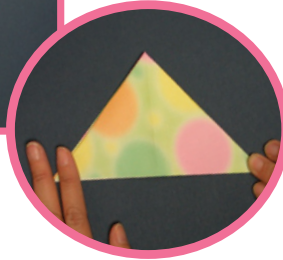
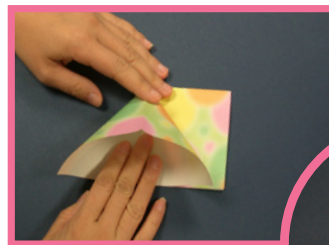
step 1

Fold your sheet into quarters to form a small square.



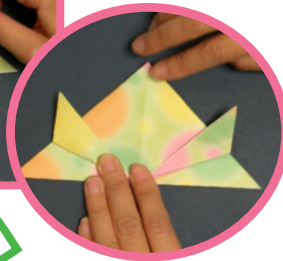
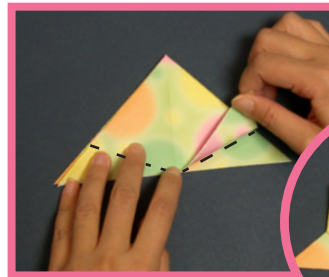
step 2

Lift up the inner pocket of the square and open up to form a triangle. Repeat on the other side.



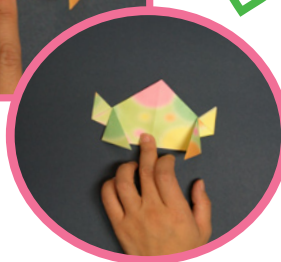
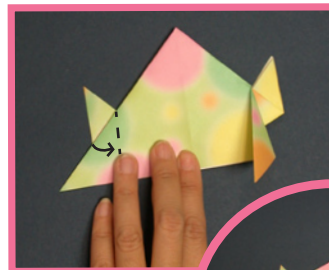
step 3

Fold up along the dotted lines to make triangular flaps.



step 4

Turn your frog over and fold along the dotted lines to form right triangles.



step 5

Fold right triangles backward and tuck underneath the body of your frog.
