

Child & Adolescent Diagnostic and Consultation Clinic (ICD-CADCC)

The Institute for Child Development's Child & Adolescent Diagnostic and Consultation Clinic was established in 2017 as a means to remove barriers to obtaining evidence-based and effective services in the local community. Our clinic's mission is to improve community access to diagnostic and consultation services in order to reduce lengthy wait times and the need to travel or consult outside of the Southern Tier of New York as the sole option for families and districts in need. Our programs include diagnostic services for an array of developmental and learning needs, parent or individual consultations for specific time-limited supports, and school district or agency consultations to bring cutting-edge training and professional education on site to those who are seeking team growth in measurable ways. ICD-CADCC serves ages 12 months to 17 years old. Referrals are accepted from legal guardians or district/agency representatives.
