

Request for Proposals

Summer Research Grant 2023



Dr. Kaschak established a research grant to benefit Harpur College undergraduate students seeking to conduct research in the field of social justice for women and/or girls. Summer 2023 research projects must in the field of **social justice for women and/or girls and related to climate change (adaptation and/or mitigation)**. The award recipient will receive a payment of up to \$1,500 in May 2023 to fund expenses directly related to the research project.

Criteria

- Must be Harpur College undergraduate student in good academic standing
- GPA must be at least 3.0
- Cannot already be funded for summer research
- Cannot receive Kaschak grant more than twice
- The recipient will share research findings with the institute's executive director.

Checklist:

- A completed application cover sheet (attached)
- A short abstract (100 words) of the project and its significance for climate change and social justice, highlighting intersectionality contexts if applicable.
- A longer proposal (approximately 2 double-spaced pages or 500 words) that includes:
 - The goal of the project and its importance with respect to social justice for women and girls;
 - The methodology of the study: how will the applicant address the questions raised in the project;
 - Work completed on the project to date and projected for the period of the award;
 - Your faculty mentor or sponsor, or your sponsor from an outside organization; your plan to register for credit (if any).
 - Your plan to use the funds for research costs, research travel, or both.
- A resume or CV, limited to two pages

Review

The Kaschak Institute Advisory Board will review submissions and select the winning proposal.

Reporting and Use of Funds

Funds must be expended during the research grant period for which they are awarded (summer months). A one-page report of the project must be submitted by mid-October of the same year to: kaschak@binghamton.edu. Kaschak Institute funded students will attend Institute events and may be asked to share their research via a brief oral presentation during the following academic year.
