

# The Maurice Leyden Collection

## Scope and Content

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2005

The Maurice Leyden Collection consists of 52 diaries, 37 letters, 24 envelopes, 28 financial documents (mostly receipts and ledgers), 13 photographs, and assorted other items. There are a total of 190 pieces of archival material. Of the 52 diaries 25 belonged to Maurice Leyden, 22 of them belonged to Sarah Woodruff Pottle, a relative of Mr. Leyden, and 4 belonged to Blanche Leyden, Maurice Leyden's daughter. One diary is unattributed and contains only four entries. The collection is arranged with the diaries first, in chronological order, followed by any notebooks and ledger books, then the unframed photographs, probably of Maurice Leyden. Following the photographs are the letters and their associated envelopes, also in chronological order, with the exception of one with no date and three that are associated with specific mortgage receipts. Financial documents, electoral documents, and essays finish out the unframed items. The last three archival boxes contain the framed items, first the framed photographs, probably of Maurice Leyden. These are followed by framed military documents in chronological order, and last is the framed Master Mason's Certificate.

Each item has been placed in an acid-free folder, with the exception of the framed items, though these were assigned folder numbers for record-keeping purposes. The diaries were placed in mylar sleeves before being put into specially constructed acid-free folders. The unframed photographs were also placed in mylar sleeves. To minimize the need for handling each item has been unfolded to the extent allowed by the folders. The collection is housed in 108 folders in twelve acid-free archival boxes totaling 8,710 cubic inches.

### The Diaries

There are three known diarists in the Maurice Leyden Collection. Most of the diaries were kept by Mr. Leyden. The last diary begun by him was completed by one of

his children, most likely Blanche Leyden. Several other diaries have been attributed to Blanche Leyden. The remaining diaries were kept by a maternal aunt of Margaret Leyden, Sarah Woodruff Pottle. Margaret Leyden was Maurice Leyden's wife. These diaries span the years 1860 to 1908. Mrs. Pottle's diaries are from the years 1860 to 1886. Maurice Leyden's diaries begin with 1871 and go to 1905 or 1906. The 1905 diary, MLD48, was definitely begun by Mr. Leyden and completed by his daughter. The 1906 diary, MLD49, has Mr. Leyden's name in the front, but the entries may all have been made by his daughter. Mr. Leyden died in 1906. Blanche Leyden left one diary from the 1890s, that is 1897, MLD39. The rest of her diaries are from 1901 to 1908.

Margaret Leyden is of particular interest in this collection as she was a protégée of Susan B. Anthony's. Maurice Leyden's 1872 diary, MLD11, has entries where he mentions the women registering to vote and actually voting. There are also entries in that diary and the following 1873 diary, MLD13, mentioning the reactions to the women voting and Susan B. Anthony's trial.

### The Letters

Maurice Leyden was a Rochester, NY dentist, businessman, banker, and politician. He held office as the Monroe County Clerk from 1885 until 1888,<sup>1</sup> and was an active member of the Monroe County Republican Party. He was also the treasurer of the 3<sup>rd</sup> New York Regiment of Cavalry. The letters are an eclectic mix of personal, business, and political. Most were written to Mr. Leyden, though a few are addressed to Margaret Leyden or Blanche Leyden. One letter, without a date, does not appear to have been written to any of the Leydens. Three of the letters concern a mortgage which Mr. Leyden may have been administrating and are housed with the mortgage receipts. The letters range in date from 14 October, 1868 to 14 December, 1919.

## Other Items

The remainder of the collection consists mostly of financial documents: bill ledgers from Mr. Leyden's dental supply business, an estate ledger from Edward Pottle's estate (with all entry pages torn out), household receipts, mortgage receipts, and other miscellaneous receipts. There are also essays on the history of the Mormons, the Acquisition of Western Lands, U.S. - Indian Relations, and the Treatment of the Negro. These essays were written on Monroe County Clerk stationery and are likely the work of Maurice Leyden. There is also the deed and mortgage for a property in Brockport, NY. The final items, before the framed items, are two family trees, or family histories, for the Garrigus family. Garrigus was Margaret Leyden's mother's maiden name.

## Framed Items

There are seven framed items in the Maurice Leyden Collection. The first three are photographs of a man astride a horse, a man standing with a horse outside of a house, and a man riding a horse in a parade. Presumably the man in each of these pictures is Maurice Leyden. The other framed items are documents. There is Mr. Leyden's commission as a 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenant in the 3<sup>rd</sup> NY Cavalry, his commission as a Captain in the 3<sup>rd</sup> NY Cavalry, and his discharge from service at the end of the Civil War. The last item in the collection is Maurice Leyden's Master Mason's Certificate.

## A Diary Collection of Relating to Margaret Leyden

Margaret Woodruff Leyden, of Rochester, NY, was one of the women who registered to vote with Susan B. Anthony on 01Nov1872. She was also one of the women voted with Ms. Anthony on 05Nov1872. Within the Civil War Manuscripts Archives in the Binghamton University Libraries there is a collection of fifty-one diaries, spanning the thirty-nine years from 1860 to 1908, which relate directly to Margaret Leyden. These diaries are in the Maurice Leyden Collection.

Twenty-five of the diaries belonged to Margaret Leyden's husband, Maurice Leyden, a Rochester, NY, dentist, businessman, and politician. Four of the diaries belonged to Margaret and Maurice Leyden's daughter, Blanche. Blanche Leyden also continued the last of Maurice's diaries after he became too ill to do so himself. The remaining twenty-two diaries belonged to Margaret Leyden's maternal aunt, Sarah Woodruff Pottle, wife of wealthy Rochester businessman, Edward Pottle. Unfortunately, of the fifty-one diaries none were written by Margaret Leyden. Maurice Leyden's diaries span the years 1871-1906. Sarah Pottle's diaries span the years 1860-1886. Blanche Leyden's diaries span the years 1897-1908.

These diaries may prove useful in research into Women's Rights: Maurice Leyden does mention the 1872 vote, and Susan B. Anthony's subsequent trial, in his 1872 and 1873 diaries. And, aside from that, Margaret Leyden is a prominent figure in both her husband's and aunt's diaries. There is, of course, potential for other research within this collection. Although the two main diarists were not of the same nuclear family, they were closely related and the diaries may afford a close, gendered, dual perspective of Rochester's upper-middle class during the latter half of the nineteenth century. This is especially true in light of the fact that for ten of the fifteen years between 1871 and 1885 there are diaries from both Maurice Leyden and Sarah Pottle.
