

## **E-Transportation Device Requirements**

## Including lithium-ion battery powered bikes, scooters and hover boards

- 1. All devices used on campus must be registered. There is no fee for this.
- 2. Always follow manufacturer's instructions.
- 3. Use only the battery and the charger that were designed for the device and that came with the device.
- 4. Only purchase and use devices, batteries, and charging equipment that are listed and labeled in accordance with UL2272 or UL2849 (Underwriters Laboratory).
- 5. Device must be plugged directly into a wall outlet during charging. Do not use extension cords or power strips.
- 6. You must be present during the entire battery charging process.
- 7. Do not block exit paths, hallways, or stairwells during charging operations or storage.
- 8. Do not continue charging the device or device battery after it is fully charged.
- 9. Only charge one device or device battery at a time.
- 10. Keep batteries at room temperature when possible. Do not charge at temperatures below 32 degrees Fahrenheit or above 105 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 11. Do not store batteries in direct sunlight or inside hot vehicles.
- 12. Do NOT ride any device inside any campus building.
- 13. Only have device repairs performed by a qualified professional.
- 14. Do NOT place lithium-ion batteries in the trash!
- 15. All users must comply with applicable traffic laws.

Please note: This does not apply to battery-operated devices such as, but not limited to, laptops, desk top computers, iPads, tablets, cell phones, ADA Mobility Devices, etc.
