Binghamton University-Upstate Accelerated Scholars Program (UAS)

This program is designed for first year pre-medical students and allows for a seamless transition from Binghamton University to Upstate's Norton College of Medicine. Students selected for the UAS will experience collateral and co-curricular experiences supporting their medical school aspirations, have mentorship opportunities for a diverse group of students, and have access to early faculty-student interaction with faculty from Upstate's Norton College of Medicine. The UAS is competitive, with five places available each year.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the UAS, first year students must have:

- A high school gpa of 90% or higher/3.50 or higher.
- A gpa of 3.50 or higher from their first semester at Binghamton University.
- SAT score of 1360 or higher (combined Critical Reading & Math) or an ACT score of 29 or higher.
- Extra-curricular activities demonstrating experience in a healthcare setting and a commitment to community service or volunteer work.

Preferred Candidates

Preferred candidates will possess the following characteristics.

- New York State residents, especially those from Central/Upstate New York.
- Be from rural or medically underserved communities.
- Be first generation college students or those with lower socioeconomic status.
- Have a professed interest in staying in Central New York with ties to the region.
