A FREE bus is available for students who reside in the NYC area.

Buses to the EOP orientations will pick up students and ONE family member at Bryant Park in Manhattan at the West 42nd Street entrance (directly across from SUNY Optometry located at 33 West 42nd St, NY, NY 10036). The bus will leave Bryant Park at 9:00 AM and return students by 8:00 PM. You will need to reserve your seat on this bus at eop.binghamton.edu. Students and parents are not required to use the bus.
