Policy Regarding Transfer Credits

Students admitted to our program who have already earned a Master's degree from another institution may petition to have courses taken at their prior institution fulfill course requirements in our program. We evaluate these requests on an individual basis and, at most, no more than 1-2 courses generally transfer. Regardless of whether or not course credit is transferred, our program is designed to take a total of 5-6 years (including the 1 year predoctoral internship).
