ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

To be considered you need to:

- Be a junior or senior (57+ credits completed)
- Maintain a solid academic record (3.0 GPA or higher)
- Show strong interest in language learning in Spanish, French, or Italian.
- Have taken at least one class in the department
- Have earned at least an A- in the course you want to assist
- Have completed one level beyond the course (e.g., for 115, completed 211)
