

Summer Funding

Lithium Landscapes and the Arts

With seed funding from the *Provost Awards for Research Grants: A Sustainable World* program, work began this summer on a cross-disciplinary collaboration between the School of the Arts and Dr. Stanley Wittingham's energy storage lab to create three major art pieces (performing and visual arts) exploring the local and global Lithium-Ion battery industry. The project includes Colin Lyons (Art & Design), Elizabeth Mozer (Theatre), Hao Liu (Chemistry), Sarah Nance (Art & Design), and Yuxin Wang (Environmental Studies).

Arts in the Community

We were thrilled by the strong response to our call for projects fostering community engagement through the arts. Funded by the *Road Map Strategic Priority 4 (SP4)*, the School of the Arts is supporting 15 projects this year and, over the fall semester, will purchase equipment to help our departments present students' work in collaboration with the surrounding community.

Film Festival in Croatia

With support from Harpur Edge and the School of the Arts, Cinema graduate students Andrew Frangella, Brian Grey, and Ben Stone have spent the summer collaborating with faculty member Monteith McCollum on a live cinematic performance they will present at the *Vladimir Film Festival* in Croatia in






