Please Note:

- Only one of the 10 courses (but not to include 100, 200 or 305) may be taken on a Pass/Fail basis.
- Courses with a grade of D do not fulfill requirements for the major. All courses required for the major must be passed with at least a C-.
- Students may count only one of the following toward the major requirements for 4 credit hours: SOC 395 (Internship); SOC 397 (Independent Study); SOC 491 (Teaching Practicum); or SOC 498 (Independent Research).
- Sociology courses taken at other colleges or universities may, in some cases, substitute for sociology courses offered at Binghamton. But we require that at least five of the 10 required sociology courses, and four of the six required upper-division sociology courses, be taken at Binghamton. In addition, some courses offered by other departments at Binghamton are "cross-listed" as sociology courses and are accepted toward the sociology major.
