**INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS:**

It is expected that doctoral students will work on research related activities in the summer months under faculty supervision.

Award of a Summer Research Scholarship is contingent on the student making satisfactory progress toward completing a dissertation in a timely fashion.

Here is what the student should do:

1. In consultation with the student's faculty advisor, the doctoral student should prepare a plan (see form on next page) that specifies what the student plans to accomplish during a proposed summer research. The purpose of a written plan is to ensure that the summer is used efficiently and effectively toward completion of the doctoral degree. A copy of the plan must be on file in the SOM PhD Program administrative offices.
2. At the end of the summer, students will submit a one-page progress report.
3. This progress report should be signed by the student's faculty advisor as to its successful completion.

The student will be paid the summer stipend upon review and approval by the SOM PhD Director.
