** Students must take three writing emphasis (C) courses to fulfill the writing requirement. One of these will also satisfy the GenEd requirement in Language and Communications.

*** CPA requirements include a course in Business Statistics so accounting students are advised to take CQS 112 as their statistics course rather than one of the Harpur statistics courses. SOM students may register for Math 147, Econ 366 or Psych 243 in place of CQS 112, **but may not take more than one of these 4 statistics courses.** (The 3 Harpur courses do not qualify as either Liberal Arts electives or as non-introductory courses).

**** PwC Scholars program students are expected to be enrolled in the Honors Seminar for each semester they are in the program. PwC Scholars program students must complete a minor in Harpur College (usually 6 courses), a secondary concentration in SOM (3 courses) or an additional accounting course. This may require one or more additional courses beyond the normal 130 credits required to graduate.

General Education courses may be taken in any order and students are not required to take them in the order shown above. PwC Scholars must complete requirements of the Binghamton Scholars program. The courses are substituted for electives above.
