\*\*SOM students may register for MATH 147, MATH 148, ECON 366 or PSYCH 243 in place of the recommended CQS 112 to satisfy the statistics requirement, but may NOT take more than one of these four statistics courses towards the degree. CQS 112 should only be taken after CQS 111 is completed.

\*\*\*Admission to the MS Accounting program is not guaranteed. Minimum GPA of 3.0 and GMAT of 580 is required. Early Admission requirements are subject to change.

\*\*\*\*All students are required to have at least 45 credits in 300 or 400 level classes.

General Education (GenEd) requirements may be taken in any sequence. The GenEd sequence shown above is just an example.
