

# Introduction to Bmail

Using the term BMail will allow users to distinguish their Binghamton University Google email account from any personal Gmail account they may have.

## Benefits

- Same email address (userid@binghamton.edu)
- No user sign-up – accounts created by ITS
- More storage – Bmail powered by Google offers over 7.3gb of free storage
- Larger attachments – send and receive 25mb attachments
- Spam and virus protection – less spam and viruses in your inbox
- No Ads – all current faculty, staff and students accounts are ad free.
- You can keep your mail address for life as long as you graduate or retire from Binghamton University
- You can read BMail on your mobile device by pointing your phone's web browser to <http://gmail.com/app>. (If you use an iPhone or iPod Touch - there is a Google App available for free download at the iTunes store.)
